Advent: We will continue our celebration of the Season of Advent with a moment of reflective prayer on the Sunday Gospels (Lectio Divina) this Tuesday which will be streamed on Facebook at 7pm and then remain on the Facebook page for viewing later. If you are participating in this time of prayer, you might want to create a prayerful atmosphere in your homes with a Crucifix or other picture/statue/icon and a candle.
