...is marked by a change of colour from green to purple to represent a more penitential season whereby we prepare for the Second Coming of Jesus, and his Nativity. Also, the music changes as we do not have the Gloria and use more simple Mass Parts. We will also use the Apostles Creed.

Finally, I would encourage everybody to stay until the end of Mass, leaving Mass early (unless for an important reason) is disrespectful and misses the 'missa'...a word that means 'sending out', from which we get the word 'Mass' and 'Mission'. The final blessing and the final hymn send us out with a Mission to spread the good news. Please don't miss the missa.

Thanks also to Mary Brannan for donating two TV's, an urn, glasses, mugs, jugs, etc. This will all be put to good use in the hall and church house.






A LOAF A WEEK?
